Raineybrook Pointe Yard Sign Guidelines

Given the numerous events, activities, and elections that happen in and around Tippecanoe County, The Raineybrook Pointe HOA wanted to provide some guidelines as it relates to putting signs up in individuals lots. It is not our objective to impede free speech, but to ensure that we continue to represent our neighborhood with the class and dignity that it is known for.

We ask all residents to adhere to the following:

- Signs of any kind can only be posted in a specific lot with the expressed permission of the property owner. Those without permission are subject to immediate removal.
- 2) Signs cannot be displayed more than thirty (30) days prior to any event or election
- 3) Signs must be removed within five (5) days after the event or election
- 4) Signs may not be larger than 5 square feet, not including the stand on which the sign is displayed
- 5) No more than three (3) signs may be placed in any lot at a given time
- 6) Signs must be placed in a mulched area so as not to impede mowing and lawn treatments. Any deviation must be done with expressed permission from the property owner.
- 7) Signs cannot be placed in the Raineybrook Pointe common areas. Any sign posted in the common area will be removed.
- 8) Signs displaying foul or vulgar language are not permitted and will be removed immediately.
